## **Tasmania Region Spiritual Retreat**

**"Where there is Love."**

**Friday evening 16<sup>th</sup> to Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> April 2010.**

Over the last many years, Tasmania has hosted an annual spiritual retreat which has of recent years become well attended by interstate visitors. The atmosphere of these retreats has been relaxed and relatively informal, although the focus has been on spiritual upliftment and expansion. Most of those who have attended the events have invariably been fully satisfied with the time they have spent and swept up in a wave of Sai love. The next Tasmanian retreat is being held in northern Tasmania at the Paper Beach Scout Camp, Carnaroo, 30 minutes drive north of Launceston.

The retreat theme is "Where there is Love". Special guest speakers attending the retreat are Moyia O'Brien and Linda Walker-Muschelknautz.

The retreat starts informally on Friday evening of 16<sup>th</sup> April and concludes after lunch on Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> April. The venue is pleasant, spacious and private, set in a peaceful semi-rural location bordering on the beautiful Tamar River. Accommodation is in segregated male and female dormitories and is basic with a separate shower and toilet block. Blankets are provided, but sheets and pillow slips are required. Sleeping bags are considered the best option for those who can bring them. Motels are situated within a short drive away for those with transport and the desire to have this type of accommodation.

Vegetarian meals are included in the fees, although we are not able to cater for specific dietary requirements. Fees for the weekend have been set at \$50 per person with discounts for students and families with school-aged children: \$45 for students, \$110 for a family of three and \$120 for a family of four.

The program includes a number of talks, interactive sessions and sharings which should prove very interesting and inspiring considering the guest speakers we have attending and the number of devotees recently returned from Puttaparthi over the Christmas period. An informal concert will be held on the Saturday evening.

The devotees from Tasmania extend a warm welcome to any from interstate who would like to join with us for this weekend with Sai and His children. However, there will be a limit to the number of visitors we can cater for so if interested, please act promptly. Transport to and from the Launceston Airport is available.

Those who wish to attend, please complete the registration form below and post it to myself.
