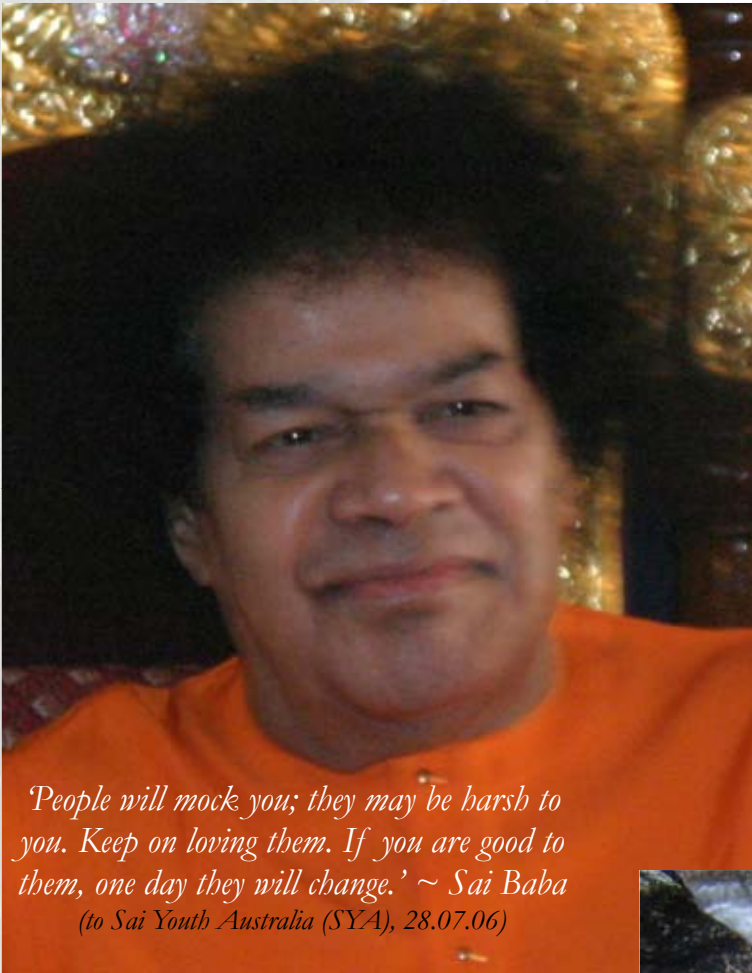


I don't want anything. I just want your love, love, love...'

'Some people say "if things just happen, why should I make any effort?" But you see, that's the art of the play. We have to make the

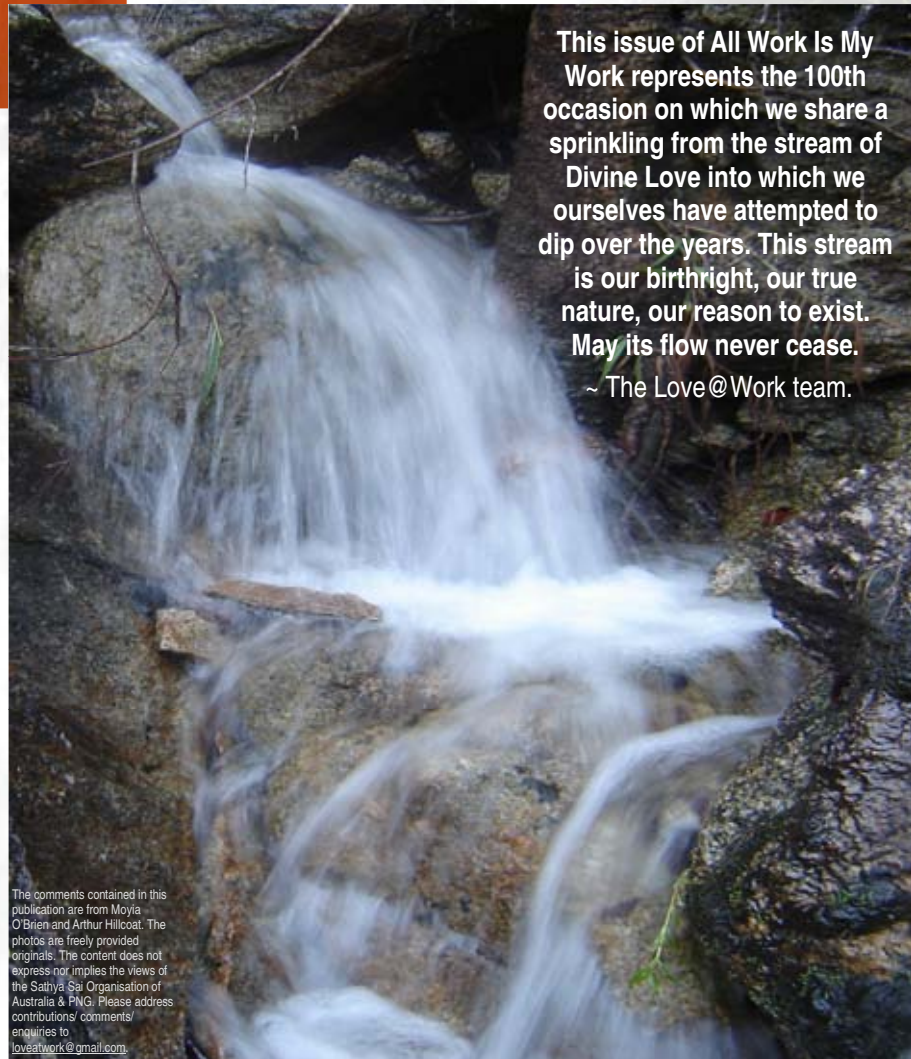
effort to play our role in the play with peace, love and harmony. So you have to continue to make effort to understand what this life is all about.'
